SEKIT gives young people clear information on how to access support and report abuse.

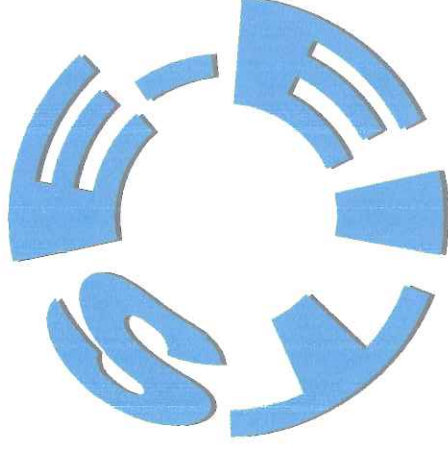

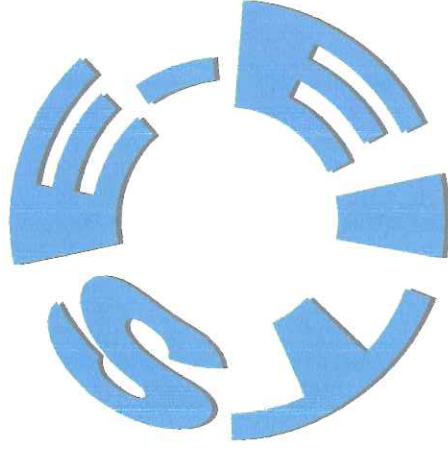
