For over 15 years ICMEC has identified gaps in the global community's ability to properly protect children from abduction, sexual abuse and exploitation, and abuse and expertly assembles the people, resources and tools needed to fill those gaps.

## Our Impact Around the World

Through the **Global Training Academy**, our Law Enforcement Training Program has reached roughly 8,000 law enforcement officers, investigators, prosecutors, and other specialists from more than 115 countries.

Since our groundbreaking publication, **Child Pornography: Model Legislation & Global Review**, was first released in 2006, more than 100 countries have refined or implemented new anti-child pornography laws.

In a survey of law enforcement using **Project VIC**, 95% said the tool helped them save time - time they are now able to spend working to identify more victims.

Our **Global Missing Children's Network**, which offers resources to law enforcement and the public at large, to assist with preventing and responding to reports of missing children, currently has 24 member countries on 4 continents.

Our **Global Health Coalition** includes 33 health-sector members, including 4 of the largest pharmaceutical companies in the world, who have joined forces to address child sexual exploitation as a public health crisis.

The **U.S. Financial Coalition Against Child Pornography**, which is made up of 90% of the U.S. payments industry (banking, credit and debit cards, pre-paid cards, etc.), has successfully disrupted the economics of the child pornography business for the past 10 years.
